## **By the bottle**

### **Champagne**

**Testulat Blanc de Blanc Brut NV, Vallée de la Marne • 82**

Made from 100% chardonnay grapes grown near Épernay. Light and subtle with notes of apple, ripe pear and quince. The palate is seasoned with subtle spices and hints of honeysuckle and grapefruit.

**Pol Roger Réserve Brut NV, Epernay • 110**

Top non-vintage from one of the last remaining family-owned houses in Champagne. The nose is dominated by white flowers, green apple, brioche and fine minerality. On the palate there's notes of stone fruits, a certain nuttiness and a hint of honey.

**Huré Frères Instantanée 2017, Montagne de Reims • 117**

A classic vintage cuvee designed to be a reflection of the year. The grapes are sourced from a variety of 1er cru vineyards and the wine is aged on the lees for six years. Rich and complex, with lovely yellow and citrus fruit on the nose and a well defined and focused palate.

**Pol Roger Sir Winston Churchill 2015, Epernay • 250**

"Rich and remarkably pure, the 2013 is super-expressive right out of the gate. Bright saline notes cut through a core of lemon confit, dried flowers, apricot, tangerine peel, mint and sage. There is a transparency here that is so alluring. The 2013 is a terrific example of power with no excess weight in Champagne." – Antonio Galloni

### **Sparkling**

**Landaluce Brut Nature NV, D.O. Cava • 40**

The Xarel-lo, Macabeo and Paralleda grapes are grown organically and then vinified separately before being blended by Asier and his team in Rioja Alavesa. No dosage is added before being bottle aged for around 15 months resulting in a dry sparkling with lots of richness.

**Artadi Izar-Leku 2018, Zarautz • 68**

A joint project between the legendary Rioja producer Artadi and Zapiain, a Basque cider producer. The base wine was aged for one year on lees, with a third of it aging in barrel, it then spent 18 months undergoing tradition sparkling fermentation in bottle. The resulting wine is aromatic, complex and has an attractive saline minerality of the region.

**Recaredo Terrers Brut Nature 2019, Penedés • 69**

Extended lees ageing and over 48 months of bottle maturation has produced this full-bodied and creamy wine with notes of white flowers, freshly baked bread and citrus.

**Gusbourne Brut Reserve 2019, Kent • 84**

Bright gold in colour, this blend highlights red fruit aromas of cherry and strawberry which then develop into attractive fresh pastry notes with a touch of cinnamon and spice. With a bright streak of citrus fruit, the palate is clean and fresh whilst giving tons of soft stone fruit and a long, refreshing finish.

**Exton Park RB 2023 Rosé, Hampshire • 98**

Based on Pinot Noir grapes picked in the very ripe year of 2014 and blended with barrel aged Pinot Noir this expressive, round English fizz is creamy with great weight and hints of spice.

## White

### Gaintza Txakoli 2022, Getaria • 40

Hand harvesting is key to the traditional winemaking methods of the area. A lively light spritz with green apples and lemons on the palate. Light with refreshing acidity makes this a quintessential traditional Txakoli.

### Elle de Landaluce 2022, Rioja Alavesa • 40

A classic Rioja blend of Viura and Malvasia from over 60-year-old vines. Aged on the lees in French oak for 2 months after fermentation which gives the wine a round, complex, creamy texture alongside tropical and citrus fruits and fresh acidity.

### Bodegas Godeval Godello 2022, Valdeorras • 45

Vines planted on the granite slopes of the mountains of El Barco de Valdeorras produce this wine full of stone fruit and pear notes with great balance between the mineral acidity and the weight of fruit. This was the first 100% Godello ever made to sell.

### Herència Altés Benufet 2022, Terra Alta • 51

100% Garnacha Blanca from Catalonia. Fermentation in concrete barrels helps retain the natural acidity and batonnage on fine lees for 2 months brings texture, depth and a slight smokey note. Great alternative to white Burgundy.

### Sameiras 1040 2020, Ribeiro • 56

An Atlantic influenced blend of Albariño, Godello, Lado and Treixadura by highly regarded winemaker Oscar Aragón. The juice is aged on its lees in French oak for 6 months producing a complex, structured wine with floral herbal notes and a long finish.

### Telmo Rodriguez Mountain Blanco 2021, Malaga • 57

100% Moscatel from high in the mountains that surround Malaga. This delicious dry white has aromas of hay, honey and nectarine and a light spiciness in the nose. In the mouth a round attack but elegant, with refreshing acidity that adds tension.

### Sabaté I Coca Castellroig So Blanc 2022, Penedes • 60

Lemon and lime dominate the nose and fennel and pine nuts join on the palate of this 100% Xarel-lo. The chalky and clay soils impart a complex minerality which balances well with the fruit and acidity.

### Sal da Terra Albariño 2021, Rias Baixas • 64

The ultimate expression of Galician Albariño from its heartland in Rias Baixas. Ripe citrus, stone fruits and white blossoms on the nose, with a stony minerality. Despite refreshing acidity there's a wonderful breath on the palate, with flavours of yellow peach, lime cordial and a sea-breeze that lingers on the finish.

### Domaine du Montillet Blanc 2021, Saint-Joseph • 71

Skillfully crafted old vine Marsanne and Roussanne by a rising star in the Northern Rhone, this wine hints of lemon, apricot, peach and marzipan with a textured and generous palate, firm minerality and slight spiciness.

### Finca Allende Blanco 2019, Rioja • 71

A blend of meticulously selected old vine Viura and Malvasia, respectively lending texture and aromatics. Aged in tightly grained French oak this wine is juicy and smooth with creamy baked apple notes and a long, fresh finish.

### **Lagar Do Merens Fermentado en Barrica 2021, Ribeiro • 78**

This barrel fermented white is a blend of Treixadura, Lado and Torrontés from lower yields and worked with lees and bâtonnage which adds clout and complexity, character and weight. Alongside, there is good freshness and vibrant flavours.

### **R López de Heredia Viña Gravonia Blanco Crianza 2014, Rioja • 84**

“Layered and complex with notes of herbs and quince, this wine is full of personality. The nuttiness on the palate is balanced by fresh acidity and complimented by jasmine. It’s made in an oxidative style, but don’t be put off – it’s a profound white.” – Jane Anson

### **Envinate Palo Blanco 2021, Tenerife • 90**

Made from four parcels of 100+ year-old Palamino vines in northern Tenerife this is a distinctly volcanic island wine: focused, saline and electric. Also in abundance are pure notes of apple, pear and spring flowers.

### **Clos Mogador Nelin 2020, Priorat • 100**

“The nose is phenomenal, with pure Mediterranean herbs, dry yellow flowers and pollen. This is showing imminent complexity and has a seamless palate that is round and balanced, with 14% alcohol (not a shy wine) but with incredible freshness. 2019 is a very balanced vintage with power, freshness and elegance. This is superb.” – Luis Gutiérrez

### **Bodegas Tameran Marmajuelo 2021, Gran Canaria • 108**

Marmajuelo is a rare grape variety, indigenous to the Canary Islands, that’s prized for it’s potential to produce expressive, fine white wines. This example is initially understated on the nose but blossoms into waves of orchard fruits and white flowers, combined with great length and texture this is almost Burgundian in style.

### **Zarate Tras da Vina Albariño 2021, Rias Baixas • 119**

“Wonderful nose that exudes freshness; it features fresh honeysuckle, loquat, freshly squeezed lemons and sea salt. The palate is really on fire, with the acidity taking off and electrifying the fleshy stone fruit on offer. Medium- to full-bodied yet zesty and so tangy on the finish.” – James Suckling

### **Castro Ventosa Valtuille Godello 2021, Bierzo • 132**

“This bottling is a selection of the best barrels. It’s a little flinty and smoky, a little à la Bourgogne, with some balsamic notes, round and complete, with very tasty flavours and great balance. It’s a little riper than the 2019, but also feels deeper and just one step above in everything. This might be the finest white produced here so far.” – Luis Gutiérrez

### **José Pariente Finca Las Comas 2020, Rueda • 132**

The Verdejo grapes hail from a 2.43-hectare bush vine vineyard planted in 1910 in the village of La Seca. Intense and creamy on the palate with aromas of fennel, herbaceous plants and a subtle touch of citrus, the wine is elegant and super well balanced.

### **Terroir Al Límit Pedra de Guix 2019, Priorat • 136**

“This shows striking concentration and oxidative complexity that’s delivered in a subtle way, with understated aromas of apricot, papaya, cement, honeysuckle, and a hint of turmeric. Flavourful, dry, and quintessential on the medium-bodied palate with a creamy, sleek mouthfeel and a nice caressing bite on the finish. Structured and fresh with medium acidity. Fun to drink now.” – James Suckling



### **R López de Heredia Viña Tondonia Blanco Reserva 2010, Rioja • 142**

“This superb, old vine cuvée from one of Rioja’s greatest vineyards is a marriage of Viura and 10% Malvasia that spend six years in barrel before bottling. Richly coloured and intense, it has notes of honey, oyster shell, dried fruits and fresh dough, with wonderful extract and concentration.” – Tim Atkin MW

### **Finca Allende Mártires 2020, Rioja • 202**

‘Smokey oak is the lead aroma on this single-vineyard barrel-fermented Rioja. A round, creamy palate is full in body and supported by oak-based tannins and medium acidity. Lightly salty apple and peach flavours on a round and oaky finish.’ – Michael Schachner

### **R López de Heredia Viña Tondonia Blanco Gran Reserva 2001, Rioja • 212**

“Wonderful aromas of almonds, nougat, dried peaches and vanilla bean follow through to a full body with a dense palate of ripe fruit and amazing, unique vanilla cream. Some candle wax and light varnish too. Historical taste of Rioja that every wine lover should try.” – James Suckling

## **Rosé**

### **Herencia Altes Garnatxa Negra Rosat 2022, Terra Alta • 40**

Light, dry and fresh in the classic Provencal style. Elegant with red berry fruit and a creamy texture with a hint of dried fennel.

### **4 Kilos Moteur Pistache 2020, Mallorca • 62**

A funky, delicious rose somewhere between a light red and a dark rose. Fermented and matured in oak foudre for nine months it has notes of rose hip and hibiscus, herbs and an earthy touch. It’s light and refreshing, with pungent flavours and a very good length.

### **Finca Allende Rosado 2018, Rioja Alta • 70**

A blend of Tempranillo and Garnacha, the nose displays fresh red fruit aromas of strawberry, cherry, redcurrant and raspberry. Subtle and soft with bright acidity and a well balanced finish.

### **R López de Heredia Viña Tondonia Rosado Gran Reserva 2011, Rioja • 132**

A very unique wine only made in exceptional vintages, this is the current release. The texture is light yet with a slight oak tannin grip. Sweet strawberries lie in the background but that acidity has an almost tart tangerine quality to it, it is so refreshing. The wine has a beautiful finish of red apple and lemon pith mixing with a touch of almonds.

## Red

### Fincas de Landaluze Crianza 2020, Rioja • 42

Located in La Rioja this small family bodega grows their Tempranillo in their own vineyards which lie 500m above sea level. This imparts a lovely freshness to the wine which proves the perfect foil to the abundant dark fruit and smokey oak.

### Gaba do Xil Mencia 2020, Valdeorras • 48

Often compared to Pinot Noir the indigenous Mencia grape performs so well in this area of Northwest Spain. Fresh and aromatic with cherry notes, a touch savory and earthy and a gorgeous lightness of touch.

### Dido La Universal 2021, Montsant • 56

A blend of organically grown Garnacha, Syrah, Cariñena, Merlot and Cabernet Sauvignon. Floral, expressive, clean and focused, with perfectly integrated oak, all the varieties complement each other, the wine has a juicy palate and astonishing balance.

### Bodegas Traslanzas 2018, Cigales • 60

Aromas of violet, lavender and fruits of the forest are evident on the nose of this 100% Tinto del Pais. Noticeable body is complemented by the sweet tannins and long, aromatic finish.

### Pegaso Zeta 2021, Cebreros Sierra de Gredos • 64

Hailing from high in the mountainous Sierra de Gredos this 100% organically grown Garnacha is laden with red current and tangy raspberry, blackberry and fig, soft tannins and a super smooth finish.

### Guimaro Finca Meixeman 2020, Ribera Sacra • 67

Made using the grapes of 70-year-old Mencia vines on a single vineyard plot, the Rodriguez family have created a serious wine with a core of kirsch-like red fruit, spice and minerals.

### Ànima Negra AN/2 2021, Mallorca • 68

A blend of Callet, Mantonegre-Fogoneu and Syrah with complex aromas of savory spices, wild raspberries, dark cherry fruit and a hint of violets and smokiness. On the palate it's silky and elegant with intense flavours of mature fruit. Well-balanced with a long finish.

### Remelluri Reserva 2015, Rioja • 76

Crafted from organically farmed grapes grown exclusively throughout the family-owned estate near Labastida, in the Basque Alavesa zone of Rioja. Remelluri is a blend of traditional Rioja varieties produced with minimal impact and low intervention. The 2015 vintage is floral, elegant and a savoury expression, combining notes of red berries, forest floor and tobacco leaves.

### Bodegas Peñafiel Miros Reserva 2018, Ribera del Duero • 76

An iconic wine for our restaurants and a wonderful example of what Ribera del Duero can offer. A blend of Tinto Fino, Cabernet Sauvignon and Merlot from old vines located on the outskirts of Peñafiel. Black cherry and blackberry fruit, layered with vanilla and spice, fine herbs, and florals.

### **Celler Pardas Collita Rojo 2015, Penedès • 76**

From a chemical-free vineyard planted in 1949 and farmed by hand, this is a unique single-varietal Sumoll wine, the ancient indigenous grape. Primary red and dark berries and scents of pungent flowers. Sappy, mineral-tinged raspberry and bitter cherry flavours deepen slowly and become sweeter as the wine opens up. Nicely weighty but vibrant as well, finishing long and juicy.

### **Terroir Al Límit Terra de Cuques Tinto 2019, Priorat • 84**

A compelling and different take on Priorat, Terroir Al Límit's philosophy is to emphasise fruit purity rather than winemaking. An equal blend of Cariñena and Garnacha, this is floral, herby and elegant, medium in weight and relatively subtle for this famous Spanish wine region.

### **Bodega Mustiguillo Finca Terrerazo 2019, Valencia • 93**

Organically farmed Bobal grapes are fermented with indigenous yeasts and then aged in large oak vats for 18 months producing a delicious wine with body, elegance, purity and fine tannins.

### **Joan d'Anguera Finca l'Argata 2020, Montsant • 99**

24 hectares are worked bio-dynamically by the seventh generation of the same family using wild yeasts and whole-bunch fermentation. This Garnacha-Syrah blend shows ripe black fruit, spices and smooth fresh tannins.

### **4 Kilos 2021, Mallorca • 100**

Hand selected indigenous varietal berries are fermented separately by plot before being blended and aged for 14 months in 600 litre French oak barrels. Persimmon, quince, ripe apples, and tea leaf on the nose. Extremely light on its feet with a delicate mouth feel. It has a sense of life and a very long finish.

### **Palacios Remondo Propiedad 2021, Rioja • 101**

Crafted from 100% de-stemmed Garnacha fermented in oak vats and aged in oak barrels for 14 months. With aromas of roses and liquorice leading to the full-bodied palate with chunky plum and black fruit notes, fine-grained tannins and good acidity.

### **Comando G Las Rozas 1er 2021, Gredos • 110**

Produced by Dani Gomez Jiménez-Landi and Fernando Garcia who share a passion for indigenous old vines and to demonstrate the potential of Grenache in the mountainous Gredos region west of Madrid. This wine has a Pinot Noir elegance, expansive red fruit, smokey nuances and a long mineral finish.

### **Clos I Terrasses Laurel 2021, Priorat • 110**

This is the second wine to the much-heralded Clos Erasmus, coming from the younger vines in the small biodynamic vineyards. Complex herbs, oaky spice and chocolate richness dominate the palate alongside charming, opulent fruit.

### **R López de Heredia Viña Tondonia Reserva Tinto 2010, Rioja • 110**

Wonderful, traditional, elegant Rioja, a result of Tondonia's extending ageing process (bottled after six years in oak barrels). Aromas of spice, leather, cherries and cigar box precede the round and crisp palate with a luxurious mouth feel and intense core of flavour.

### **Castro Ventosa Valtuille Cepas Centenarias 2021, Bierzo • 110**

Expertly crafted by Raul Perez at his family estate in Galicia, this is mainly from extremely old Mencia vines, aged for 11 months in French oak. Although the palate is medium bodied there are very intense flavours and great power, balance and a super long finish.

### **Bodega Valdaya 2019, Ribera del Duero • 112**

"The straight Valdaya release is made with fruit from three different soil types in remote, high-altitude Baños de Valdearados. Intensely floral and refined as Marta Ramas and Miguel Fisac's wines always are, this is a polished Ribera with chalky intensity, fine-boned tannins and layers of plum and blueberry fruit." – Tim Atkin

### **Bodegas Frontonio Electricidad Garage Wine VIII 2019, Aragón • 112**

An extremely small production one off project by Master of Wine Fernando Mora. Mazuelo (Carignan) and Macabeo are co fermented producing a wine similar in style to a fine Côte-Rôtie. A complex wine with layered flavours of rose petals, mocha, raspberries and blackcurrants.

### **Artadi Valdegines 2018, Rioja • 114**

"This is elegant and nuanced, subtle and insinuating, cool and harmonious. I like very much the character of this vineyard that in 2018 seems accentuated by the style of the year. It has very fine tannins and great harmony in the palate with a fine, velvety texture. This is my favourite vineyard in this price range. Elegant and fresh." - Robert Parker

### **Psi 2018, Ribera del Duero • 128**

"A rich red with chocolate, ripe fruit, walnuts and spice. Full-bodied and round with ripe tannins and a flavourful finish. Plenty of ripe fruit at the intense finish and lots of old-vine character with bark and wet-earth undertones. Real deal." – James Suckling

### **Ànima Negra AN 2019, Mallorca • 128**

"Deep in flavour, polished in texture, and intensely evocative, Ànima Negra's exceptional cuvée spends 18 months in new French oak, but the character of the old Callet vines shines through. A glimpse of the Med, with flashes of fresh fig and leafy herb, a touch of balsamic and olive, and a flash of red fruit. Long and fine." – David Williams

### **Terroir Al Limit Arbossar 2020, Priorat • 138**

"Wow. This is so beautiful with crushed cherry and strawberry character and hints of flowers and slate. Full to medium body, tight and dense with compact and silky tannins. Floral and beautiful at the end. Ancient-vine wine. All Cariñena." – James Suckling

### **Remelluri Granja Reserva 2012, Rioja • 142**

"The DNA of Remelluri is here. Wild mountain herb character, structured and firm, these tannins are succulent and deeply expressive. Powerful and assertive red plums, wild cherries and roasting herbs with the oak sitting well. Power and balance." - James Suckling

### **Finca Allende Mingoritz 2015, Rioja • 143**

"The 2015 Mingoritz is pure Tempranillo from an organically farmed vineyard in Briones that gives the wine its name. It's ripe but harmonious, modern, clean and expressive, with the chalky tannins that give that serious mouthfeel." – Thomas Matthews

### **Clos Mogador Manyetes 2018, Priorat • 146**

“The pure Cariñena 2018 Manyetes is now a Vi de Paratge, not only a village wine as in the past, in the new classification of Priorat wines. The wine is not as concentrated as it has been in some warmer years; it’s definitely fresher, with more minerality, black stones, graphite and wet slate. This has abundant tannins and some earthy sensations. It’s a powerful wine with some rusticity and a strong personality” – Luis Guitérrez

### **Clos Mogador 2019, Priorat • 146**

The vines here grow on slate soils and the 2020 wine is a blend of 45% Garnacha, 29% Cariñena, 16% Syrah and 10% Cabernet Sauvignon, fermented using 30% whole bunches and indigenous yeasts. “Complex nose with notes of blood orange, black cherry and Mediterranean herbs. Intensity but also drive on the palate; great mineral acidity, freshness” – David Williams

### **Pintia 2018, Toro • 152**

“The nose is very expressive, with bright cherry fruit, and the wine is fresher than the norm in the region, with integrated alcohol and oak, reflecting a cool year, floral and perfumed. The palate is medium-bodied and reveals very fine and elegant tannins. This has to be one of the finest vintages of Pintia.” – Robert Parker

### **Las Alas de Frontonio La Tejera 2019, Valdejalón • 152**

“This is aromatic and elegant, ethereal, perfumed- I have never noticed such elegance in this wine before. The palate is very elegant, with very fine tannins and subdued minerality, long, elegant. It has electric minerality and citrus freshness. This was a revelation, full of energy.” – Luis Gutiérrez

### **Espectacle 2020, Montsant • 157**

“A ripe and classic vintage for this exceptional wine produced from a single vineyard. This has a forward personality- open, expressive and showy on the nose- from a typically warm and ripe year that resulted in a voluptuous and hedonistic Espectable that’s easy to like.” – Luis Gutiérrez

### **Bodegas Benjamin Rothschild and Vega Sicilia Macan 2018, Rioja • 162**

“A beautiful, complex nose with creamy spices, cedar, fresh blackberries, red plums, truffles and hints of walnuts and mocha. Medium to full body with multidimensional tannins that are tight as a rock, coating the palate in a linear way, penetrating from the entry to the end with a final thud.” – James Suckling

### **Alión 2019, Ribera del Duero • 172**

“Ripe, tarry plums and black cherries with violets, coffee and graphite. Refined notes of balsamic fruit and cocoa powder, too. ### **Wine (75ml)**

**Clos Lapeyre “La Magendia” 2018, Jurançon • 7**

Hailing from near to Biarritz this dessert wine is made of late-harvested botrytised Petit Manseng grapes. Medium bodied on the palate with a ‘fat’ texture leading to tropical fruit flavours that are balanced by spicy wood notes.

**Telmo Rodriguez MR White 2021, Malaga • 9**

“It’s perfumed, expressive and with the character of Molino Real, with less complexity, with the notes of bay leaf and condensed milk, balanced, rich, expressive and long, not too sweet.” – Luis Gutiérrez

**Alta Alella Dolç Materó 2019, Alella • 11**

Organic sweet red wine made from the late-harvested indigenous Catalan variety Mataró. Notes of candied plums, dried figs and blackberries and a wonderful balance between the soft tannins, acidity and sweetness.

**Telmo Rodriguez Molino Real 2016, Malaga • 18**

“It’s very intense on the palate, sweet but with a kind of lightness that makes it more aerial, not ethereal but not heavy at all and with freshness. It keeps the level in this very unusual year.” – Luis Gutiérrez

### **Fortified (50 ml)**

**Quinta da Pedra Alta “Pedra No. 03 White Port, Douro • 6**

The palate is lightly spiced with candied peel, orange marmalade, peach and fresh lemon citrus, supported by a good seam of acidity leading to a crisp finish with herbal hints.

**Emilo Hidalgo PX NV, Jerez • 7**

Drying the Pedro Ximenez grapes on straw mats helps to create a wine of unsurpassed sweetness. On the nose there’s molasses, toffee and Christmas pudding notes. The palate is incredibly thick and dense with flavours of raisins, figs, caramel, nuts and toffee.

**Smith Woodhouse 10-year Tawny Port, Douro • 7**

A perfect tawny colour gained through ageing in small oak barrels. Full of plum and raisin aromas with a long deep finish, slightly less sweet than the norm.

**Lustau East India Solera, Jerez • 8**

An intriguing blend of Palamino Fino and Pedro Ximenez aged separately for 12 years and then married together for the final three. Rich and full bodied with notes of prune, burnt-orange peel, spice and nuts.

**Warre’s Quinta de Cavadinha 2005, Douro • 10**

A lovely single Quinta just entering it’s drinking window. Seductive flavours of black plums and cherries, with an elegant long and complex finish.

**Lustau Pedro Ximenez VORS 30 Year Old, Jerez • 25**

This superb Pedro Ximenez comes from one cask selected from a Solera of six set aside as a family reserve in the 1930’s. Dense and complex with notes of fig, raisin, liquorice and hints of roasted coffee. On the palate dominate notes of toasted caramel, liquorice, nuts and bitter chocolate.
